Issue: County Administrator's Report - Sale of Surplus Equipment

Summary:

It has been 2 years since the County has conducted a sale of surplus equipment. We now have 9 vehicles that have reached the end of their useful life. Eight are former sheriff vehicles, have been released from duty by the Sheriff and are currently housed at the County maintenance shop. One is a GMC pickup used by the County staff. The vehicles are as listed:

It is recommended the vehicles be sold through the Virginia Department of General Services via the Virginia Surplus program. Based on past sales data the prices obtained by Virginia Surplus are at least triple what we have obtained selling them ourselves. Virginia Surplus will take the cars from our lot to their sale site and will jump all dead batteries if required. Virginia Surplus charges 15% of the sales price for their services.
