- CITIZEN VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES -

The Prince Edward County Board of Supervisors has adopted the following policy for advertising vacancies on County Boards/Commissions/Committees requiring citizen representation:

“To provide the maximum opportunity for citizen participation in our local government, it is the policy of the Prince Edward County Board of Supervisors to advertise all vacancies on county boards, commissions and committees, etc., which call for citizen representation. Citizens interested in serving on a County board, commission or committee may complete the County’s Citizen Volunteer Application, which will be reviewed by the Board during the appointment process.”
