This election will be for Senate of Virginia 22nd District, House of Delegates 60th District, Commonwealth's Attorney, Sheriff, Commissioner of Revenue, Treasurer, Soil and Water Conservation Directors(2) Piedmont District, Board of Supervisors in District 1, 2, 4, and 8 and also for School Board in District 1, 2, 4, and 8. District 5 (Pct. 501-Darlington Heights and 502- Buffalo Heights) will vote for Board of Supervisors for the unexpired term to end 12/31/2021, and District 7 (Pct. 701- West End) will also vote for School Board for the unexpired term to end 12/31/2021.

Tuesday, November 5, 2019: Election Day! ALL Absentee voted ballots must be returned to the Prince Edward Voter Registration and Elections Office **by 7 p.m.** to be counted.
