March 16, 2010

At a reconvened meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Prince Edward County, held jointly with the School Board of Prince Edward County, in the Prince Edward County Schools Career and Technical Center, Eagle Drive, Farmville, Virginia, on Tuesday, March 16, 2009 at 5:00 p.m., there were present:

Chairman Dove called the School Board to order.

Chairman Fore called the Board of Supervisors to order at 5:00 p.m., as a reconvened meeting in order to meet with the Prince Edward County School Board to discuss their budget.

Supervisor McKay offered the invocation.

School Board Chairman Dove introduced the new superintendent, Dr. K. David Smith, who will begin May 1, 2010.

Dr. Osa Sue Dowdy entered the meeting at this time.

Following dinner, Cindy Wahrman gave an overview of the budget proposed for FY 2010-2011. She said state revenues will be cut between \$1.1 million up to \$2.1 million. She said they are waiting for final word regarding VRS rates.

Mr. Wade Bartlett, County Administrator, asked if it is yet known what VRS will do in the final quarter of this year. Ms. Wahrman said she has no confirmation regarding the VRS holiday for the last

quarter of the fiscal year. The holiday would provide a savings of approximately \$189,000. It would offset the cut for the rest of this fiscal year; instead of approximately \$417,000, it would equal a cut of approximately \$280,000

Mr. Stanley Jones, Division Superintendent, said state funding cut for the rest of FY 10 is \$417,000.

Mr. Russell Dove, School Board Chairman, asked if schools can expect level funding. Mr. Bartlett said the Board's direction is to try to level fund with the exception of the debt service.

Mr. Dove then asked about the carry-over of funds in the amount of \$377,000. Chairman Fore said it is too early in the budget process to be able to tell.

Mr. Bartlett asked about the main use of the \$377,000. Mr. Dove said it would be spent on improvements to the football field as there is a need to repair unsafe playing surfaces. He said it would not go to operational expenses.

Mr. Dove presented a break-down of the Carry-Over Funds as follows:

Supervisor Wiley asked if the repairs are permanent or temporary until a new complex can be built. Mr. Dove said repairs are currently necessary and dependent upon the timing of funding for new facilities. Further discussion followed.

Chairman Fore stated the Board of Supervisors should know by April 13 on the carry-over funding issue.

Mr. Dove requested a meeting in October 2010 to discuss long-range capital planning.
