- 1. All projects shall conform to the standards and specifications and other criteria adopted by. Amelia County unless a variance has been granted in writing by this locality.
- 2. The issued permit must be kept on the work site and shown on request.
- 3. The locality must be notified when work commences and when the project is completed.
- 4. Other work (grading, excavating, construction) on the project shall not commence until the appropriate erosion and sediment controls are in place as specified by the approved erosion and sediment control plan.
- 5. Applicant agrees to be responsible for any and all damages to any other conservation measures already in place as a result of work covered by this permit.
- 6. Applicant agrees to maintain the conservation measures in satisfactory operating condition until final, permanent stabilization is achieved.
- 7. The stormwater management permit may be revoked, should the locality determine that the project is not in compliance with the conditions of the approved plan.
- 8. Applicant agrees to pay a permit modification fee, including a possible increase in the permitting fee, when a modification to the existing permitted project is requested by the applicant or designated agent.
- 9. Applicant agrees to pay a permit maintenance fee if the permitted activity remains active or is not terminated before the anniversary date of the issuance of permit coverage.
