Summary:

A County Sheriff's Deputy recently had a collision with a deer in a 2011 Crown Vic. The insurance company has totaled this vehicle and will provide the County with \$9,775. This car needs to be replaced with a Dodge Charger at a cost of \$28,000 which includes \$3,500 to completely outfit the new vehicle. The difference of \$18,225 can be offset without increasing the existing FY15 budget. Due to vacancies in the Planning Department over \$88,000 in the Salary & Wages accounting line will not be expended in FY15.

Recommendation:

I recommend the Board accept and appropriate the revenue from the insurance company and approve the transfer of \$18,225 dollars from the Planning Department to the Sheriff's Department and authorize the Sheriff to purchase a Dodge Charger. The required budget amendments are displayed below.

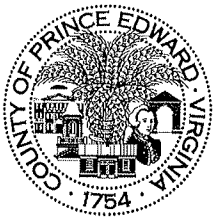

Summary:

The Piedmont Regional Jail Board has the opportunity to purchase approximately 33 acres of land adjoining the Jail at fair market value. The attached resolution of support affirms that the Jail Board should pursue the purchase of the land for future expansions.

The purchase would not require additional funds from the localities, as there are funds available in the budget of the Piedmont Juvenile Detention Center budget that could be utilized for that purpose.

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PURCHASE OF REAL PROPERTY
BY THE PIEDMONT REGIONAL JAIL BOARD

WHEREAS, the Piedmont Regional Jail Board has the opportunity to purchase certain real property located in the Farmville Magisterial District of Prince Edward County, Virginia, and containing 33 acres, which said real property lies contiguous to the real property on which the Piedmont Regional Jail is located; and

WHEREAS, the Piedmont Regional Jail Board has determined that it would be in the best interest of Piedmont Regional Jail to purchase said real property for future expansions and/or relocations; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined and agreed that the said real property can be acquired for the fair market value, as determined by an independent appraisal commissioned by the Piedmont Regional Jail Board; and

WHEREAS, there is on deposit with the Piedmont Juvenile Detention Center funds sufficient to pay for the purchase of the said real property and related closing costs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of the Piedmont Juvenile Detention Center is in agreement with the use of its funds on deposit to pay for the purchase of the said real property by Piedmont Regional Jail; and

WHEREAS, the "Agreement" made and entered into on January 1, 1986 that established the Piedmont Regional Jail Board, grant authority to that Board for *acquisition of land for the Jail for joint ownership by the parties hereto*;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Prince Edward, Virginia supports and affirms the decision of the Piedmont Regional Jail Board to purchase, at fair market value as determined by an independent appraisal commissioned by the Piedmont Regional Jail Board, that certain real property containing 33 acres situated in the Farmville Magisterial District of Prince Edward County, Virginia and adjoining the real property currently owned and occupied by the Piedmont Regional Jail; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Prince Edward, Virginia supports the transfer/pay out of funds by the Piedmont Juvenile Detention Board to affect the purchase of the above-described real property by the Piedmont Regional Jail Board.

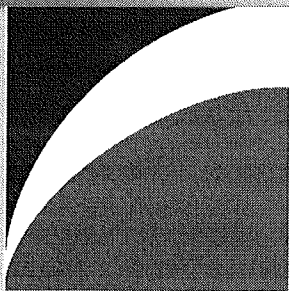
