

He then said there may be additional interest from county employees due to two recommendations on the County budget: a raise and a change in the insurance. He stated the meeting is a work session for the school budget and to discuss these two issues, but will not permit input from the employees. Any comments can be presented at the public hearing at a later time.

Mr. Bartlett said the bids received on the RFP for insurance are no better than Local Choice. Some discussion followed on the various services and plan deductibles available.

Supervisor Cooper-Jones left the meeting at this time.



Aroclamation

By the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS of the County of PRINCE EDWARD, VIRGINIA

WHEREAS, the safety and security of the citizens of Prince Edward County and surrounding areas are

vitally important; and

WHEREAS, a large percentage of our citizens regularly drive or ride in motor vehicles on our roadways;

and

WHEREAS, the use of seat belts in passenger vehicles saved an estimated 11,949 lives in 2011; and

WHEREAS, regular seat belt use is the single most effective way to protect people and to reduce fatalities

in motor vehicle crashes;

WHEREAS, the use of seat belts is supported by the laws of Prince Edward County;

WHEREAS, May 20 through June 2, 2013, has been selected as the national *Click It or Ticket*

mobilization enforcement period;

WHEREAS, across the country law enforcement officers will actively be participating in the mobilization

to ensure all motor vehicle occupants are buckled up day and night to reduce the risk of

injury and death caused in traffic crashes;

AND WHEREAS, increased enforcement of seat belt laws coupled with publicity has proven to be an effective

method to increase seat belt use rates and decrease fatal crashes;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Prince Edward County, does hereby proclaim and announce May 20 to June 2, 2013, as the *Click It or Ticket* Mobilization in Prince Edward County, and urge all citizens to always wear seat belts when driving or riding on our roadways.

Fire & EMS Memorial Week

WHEREAS, the volunteer firefighters and the emergency medical services personnel who serve the County of Prince Edward play an essential role in saving lives and protecting property in the communities of Prince Edward County; and

WHEREAS, there were over four thousand (4,000) fire and EMS responses in Prince Edward County during 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Prince Edward, Virginia, recognizes and values these brave individuals who unselfishly risk their lives in order to safeguard the lives and property of our citizens; and

WHEREAS, we hold dear in our hearts the families of David Paul Bruce and Joel Franklin Coleman, Jr., whose loved ones made the ultimate sacrifice and who we remember and honor through the *Prince Edward County In The Line of Duty Memorial*, and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that we recognize our County firefighters and emergency medical services personnel, both past and present, in light of the sacrifices and continued dedication of these local heroes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Prince Edward, Virginia, does hereby recognize June 2-8, 2013 as FIRE & EMS MEMORIAL WEEK in the COUNTY OF PRINCE EDWARD, dedicated to honoring Fire and EMS personnel who have given their lives in the line of duty; and

FURTHERMORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Prince Edward, Virginia, calls upon all citizens, businesses, and civic, and educational organizations to lower their State flags to half-staff on Sunday, June 2, 2013, and to observe the week of June 2-8, 2013 in memory of the selfless service and dedication of our fire and emergency medical services personnel who have died in the line of duty and in honor of those who continue to serve our County so selflessly; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Prince Edward, Virginia, does hereby issue this proclamation and encourages all of the citizens of Prince Edward County to remember all fire and emergency medical services personnel who have made the ultimate sacrifice in service to their community and to pay respects to the survivors of our fallen heroes, and to express your appreciation and support to the volunteer firefighters and the emergency medical services personnel who by their faithful and loyal devotion to duties continue to render invaluable service to the citizens of Prince Edward County.
