## **Treasurer's Report**

**February Financial Statements:** The Treasurer stated the January Financial Statement was enclosed in the Council packet for review.

Mr. Walker moved to accept the Financial Statement as presented. Motion carried.

#### **Report of Officers & Committees**

## **Chairman's Report**

Report on Chief Administrative Officers Meeting: Ms. Hickman reported a copy of the Agenda for the February Chief Administrative Officer's meeting was included in the Council packet for review. Ms. Hickman stated the meeting was well attended. The 2012 General Assembly created legislation that will provide automatic coverage in the VRS Virginia Local Disability Program for new hires hired on or after January 1, 2014 or current employees who opt to switch to the Hybrid Retirement Plan. Governing bodies have until September 1, 2013 to opt out of the program but would be required to provide a comparable plan for applicable employees. Following the meeting, participants stayed to view a VRS Webinar on the "Introduction to Virginia Local Disability Program (VLDP)."

**Scheduling of CRC Budget Committee Meetings:** The Chairman appointed all of the CRC Representatives to the Budget Committee. The Budget Committee will meet 1 hour prior to the CRC meetings beginning in April 2013 until the budget is complete.

Ms. Hickman noted that there was a proposed 2012-2014 budget amendment to provide a 10% increase in the state support for each PDC. Ms. Hickman stated however she received word that this amendment was not included in the conference report or the budget bill that was approved by the House and Senate. Therefore, it appears the PDC's funding will remain the same for the upcoming fiscal year.

#### **Old Business**

#### President & Staff Reports:

**Status Report – CRC Charter Amendments-Attorney General Opinion:** The Chairman stated he still has not received any notification from the Attorney General's office. The Chairman stated this issue will be kept on the Agenda until notification is received.

**Update-CRC Website Redesign:** Ms. Foster reported that CRC had contacted the low bidder of the RFP for Website Redesign to make sure that the proposal would include specific language regarding making the website responsive for mobile devices. The low bidder, Convoy, Inc. did agree to this and the contract was signed between Convoy and the CRC at the stated price of \$12,500 for website redesign services. Ms. Foster stated CRC staff and Ms. Stish will be meeting for the first time with Convoy Representatives on Friday, March 8, 2013.

**Staff Update – Presentations of CRC FY 11-12 Annual Report:** Ms. Hickman stated she will be making the final County Annual Report Presentation to Cumberland County on March 12, 2013. Ms. Hickman stated she will now begin making presentations to the Towns. Ms. Hickman stated a schedule

of the Town meetings was enclosed in the Council member packets.

**Staff Update – CRC FY 13-14 Budget Request:** Ms. Hickman stated Budget Requests have been sent to Amelia, Buckingham, Charlotte, Cumberland, Lunenburg, Nottoway, Prince Edward, Longwood University and Hampden-Sydney. Ms. Hickman stated she will also be sending a Budget Request to Farmville and Blackstone after appearing before them to present the CRC's Annual Report.

There was discussion on localities and higher institutions that are currently not members of the CRC but are eligible for membership.

**Staff Report on DHCD Continuum of Care Information Meeting Hosted by CRC:** Ms. Hickman noted as stated previously, the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) contacted the CRC and requested the CRC assist them in putting together a regional meeting with representatives from identified groups to discuss the Continuum of Care/Planning Group concept for the Planning District 14 region. Ms. Hickman stated that at the February CRC meeting the CRC agreed to host the meeting.

Ms. Hickman stated the CRC hosted the Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development's Planning District 14 Informational Meeting, "Continuum of Care/Planning Group" on February 25, 2013. Ms. Hickman stated the meeting was well attended and provided a copy of the sign-in sheet in the Council Members packet. Ms. Hickman stated there was an opportunity for participants to meet one-on-one following the forum to hold additional discussions on the subject. Participants were asked to contact DHCD after the meeting for further information/guidance as to grant opportunities coming up for the Continuum of Care and Homeless Services Funding for the Spring 2013 application.

**Council Member Comments:** None.

#### **New Business**

#### **President & Staff Reports**

**Adoption of CRC FY 13-14 Rural Transportation Planning Scope of Work and Resolution:** Ms. Foster stated enclosed in the Council Members packet is a copy of the CRC's FY 2014 Rural Transportation Planning Work Program through VDOT. Ms. Foster went over the Work Program and pointed out some of the new items listed including the CRC staff conducting a Pilot Intersection Analysis of an intersection identified in the CRC's Rural Long Range Transportation Plan and will identify potential improvements for safety and/or congestion. VDOT will provide assistance with the Pilot project. CRC will receive \$58,000 with the CRC providing a \$14,500 match for VDOT funding.

Mr. Wingold moved to adopt the CRC FY 13-14 Rural Transportation Planning Scope of Work and Resolution as presented. Motion carried.

**Adoption of 2013 Virginia CDBG Program Regional Priorities:** Ms. Terry reported that each year the Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development contacts all Planning Districts to request assistance in setting CDBG Program Regional Priorities. Ms. Terry stated the CRC localities were sent a request to rate nine categories into three regional priorities. The CRC has utilized these priorities to determine the CRC's Regional Priorities as presented in the Council members' packet.

Ms. Stish moved to adopt the 2013 CDBG Regional Priorities for Planning District 14 as presented. Motion carried.

**Recommendations on Roadway Functional Classification (Lynchburg Construction District Localities) Comments:** Ms. Foster stated CRC staff assisted VDOT in providing data to the localities of the Lynchburg Construction District on proposed changes to the Roadway Functional Classification as proposed by VDOT based on FHWA guidelines. A meeting was held prior to the February 26<sup>th</sup> Chief Administrative Officer's meeting for those wishing to discuss the proposed changes. The Town of Farmville was the only locality that submitted comments concerning the proposed changes. The CRC followed up with a letter endorsing Farmville's comments. A copy of the CRC's letter was provided in the Council members' packet.

**Council Member Comments: None** 

<u>Commonwealth Intergovernmental Review Process</u>: There were none.

<u>Council Member Comments</u>: Ms. Stish reported that a Buckingham County School Bus recently had an accident on an unpaved road in the County that was soft from rain and snow resulting in the bus turning over. Ms. Stish questioned if the CRC could work with the School Divisions to identify the worst unpaved roads in the region that buses travel on and determine if there was a collective solution to getting funding for paving. Ms. Foster stated the CRC's Transportation Committee will be meeting in the coming months and could discuss the issue with VDOT to determine a course of action.

**Other Business:** Ms. Hickman stated the CRC received a request from Prince Edward County to assist the Prince Edward Volunteer Rescue Squad in applying for a grant from the Rescue Squad Assistance Fund to purchase automatic CPR machines.

Ms. Stish moved that the CRC approve the request to assist Prince Edward Volunteer Rescue Squad. Motion carried.

Mr. Paul Hoffman with Congressman Hurt's office announced that an Elected Official Appreciation Luncheon will be held during the last week of March for Congressman Hurt's district localities.
