Issue: PUBLIC HEARING: Amendments to FY 12 County Budget

Summary: Section 15.2-2507 of the *Code of Virginia*, requires a public hearing when the Board of Supervisors makes amendments to the County Budget when such amendment exceeds one percent of the total expenditures shown in the adopted budget.

The amendments proposed by the Board of Supervisors are as follows:

1. Amendment to the General Fund of \$1,927,751 to allow the purchase of property for \$384,150, payment of \$108,981 in Bond Issuance cost associated with the VRA 2011 Bond and the transfer of \$1,434,620 from the General Fund to the VDOT Revenue Sharing fund. Revenue are \$1,494,857 from the VRA 2011 Bond and \$432,894 from Fund Balance.
2. Amendment to the VDOT Revenue Sharing Fund of \$3,694,600 to fund the Construction (\$3,122,059) and Property Acquisition for Route 786. Revenues are \$1,759,980 in State Revenue Sharing Funds, \$500,000 from VDOT, and \$1,434,620 from the General Fund.

The Board of Supervisors have held public hearings for this VDOT Revenue Sharing Project, the VRA financing package to fund the project and the condemnation of the right of way of the various land required to complete the project but has not held a public hearing to adjust the budget for the purchase of the additional land costing \$384,150.

At a special meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Prince Edward County, held at the Court House, thereof, on Friday, the 3rd day of February 2012; at 9:00 a.m., there were present:

Chairman Fore called the meeting to order, stating the purpose of the meeting is for a work session.

In Re: DMME Grant for STEPS, Inc.

Mr. Bartlett, County Administrator, stated that in 2011, the County received a \$668,003 grant from the Virginia Department of Mines, Minerals and Energy (DMME) to assist STEPS, Inc. with the replacement of the HVAC system in the STEPS Centre Building (formerly Craddock-Terry). That project is complete. The County has just been notified that an additional \$350,000 is available to be awarded to assist STEPS with the replacement of the roof. DMME is willing to award the additional funds through an amendment to the existing grant agreement between DMME and the County and the existing construction contract between TRANE and the County. This funding requires no local funds. These are federal dollars that flow through the State and will flow through The County to STEPS.

Supervisor Simpson made a motion to approve receipt of the grant funds and approve an appropriation of \$350,000; and to authorize an amendment to the County's contract with TRANE, the

contractor who will carry out the construction, and authorize the County Administrator to execute the contract amendment; and to authorize the County Administrator to execute all grant agreement documents and the disbursement of the grant funds in an upfront lump-sum payment to enable the County / STEPS to receive the pricing discount from TRANE; and to authorize an amendment to the County’s contract with the CRC to administer the additional grant funds and authorize the County Administrator to execute the contract amendment. In Re: FY 13 County Budget

Mr. Bartlett presented an update on the County revenues which are above budget projections. He stated the Expenses will not change much; VRS may increase the rate and the state has lowered anticipated investment returns. Mr. Bartlett stated there is a possible increase in fuel costs, and the debt service will increase for a few years but will decrease significantly after five years, beginning in 2018.

Discussion followed regarding:

- water and sewer
- space request from Social Services.
- Cars needed in the Sheriff’s Department
- Possible need for new computers

Mr. Bartlett stated the Prince Edward County schools have requested \$2.2 million in addition to the \$8.1 million previously budgeted; he stated the entire County budget is just under \$19 million.

Supervisor Gantt suggested waiting to see what action the General Assembly will take.

After some discussion on each topic, the Board concurred the Charitable Organizations and the Fire & Rescue should be level funded.

Mr. Bartlett stated no Special Projects are anticipated.

Mr. Bartlett then stated staff will be reviewing the fleet of County vehicles in the next two weeks; discussion followed regarding the use of old Sheriff Department vehicles for County staff.

Discussion followed on a bonus or raise for County employees.

Supervisor Gantt requested detailed information on a raise of 1.5%. He stated \$70,000 is spent towards VRS and must be taken into consideration. Discussion followed regarding the Cost of Living Allowance (COLA); the Board concurred that Mr. Bartlett provide the Board with figures for a maximum raise of 3.6% (COLA), VRS, and anticipated insurance costs. The Board also concurred to keep Plan II for VRS for employees.

Discussion followed on Operational and Programming Adjustments; several issues were discussed regarding the convenience sites.

Chairman Fore asked about the Visitor Center. Mr. Bartlett stated it is open more than required, due to grants and the older workers and volunteers. Mrs. Sarah Puckett, Assistant County Administrator, stated the highway signs directing visitors to the center will be posted in about a week; the High Bridge Trail will not have its own visitor's center; an exhibit will be housed in the County's visitor's center. Chairman Fore added the High Bridge is scheduled to open in April. [2012].

Supervisor Gantt requested communication be re-opened with the Town of Farmville regarding working together on the water project.

Mr. Bartlett then stated he would work on preparing a budget holding all tax rates and fees level; he will look at the Sheriff's and County's vehicle fleets, a raise of up to 3.6% (COLA) and keep all else the same.

Mr. Bartlett presented a Budget Development Schedule.

Chairman Fore called the meeting to order, stating the purpose of the meeting is for a public hearing on the Initiation of Condemnation Proceedings by Prince Edward County, Virginia, to Acquire Certain Property Interests Necessary for County Purposes.

In Re: Public Hearing – Initiation of Condemnation Proceedings

Chairman Fore announced that this was the date and time scheduled for a public hearing on the Initiation of Condemnation Proceedings by Prince Edward County, Virginia, to Acquire Certain Property Interests Necessary for County Purposes. Notice of this hearing was advertised according to law in the Friday, January 27, 2012 and Friday, February 3, 2012 editions of THE FARMVILLE HERALD, a newspaper published in the County of Prince Edward.

Mr. Bartlett, County Administrator, stated that at the November 17, 2011 meeting of the Board of Supervisors, the Board approved the acquisition of all property required to proceed with the construction of the Route 628/786/15 project. Since that time the County has attempted to negotiate the acquisition of property fronting State Route 15 owned by Davis Real Properties, LLC, Tax Map #051-9-A. This property

is a 173.395 acre tract which includes an approximate 150.795 acre tract fronting on the west site of State Route 15. This project requires the acquisition of 0.919 acres in fee simple and 0.447 acres will be encumbered with a permanent utility easement. The County had the property appraised and on Friday, January 13, 2012 via certified mail, a packet of information was sent to Davis Real Properties, LLC. That packet contained the appraisal and the County's final offer. The letter informed Davis Real Properties, LLC that it must accept the offer or reach a negotiated settlement no later than January 23, 2012 or the County would be forced to acquire the property by eminent domain. Davis Real Properties, LLC has not responded to the letter. Mr. Bartlett stated he spoke to Mrs. Davis on January 23, 2012 and she stated her position has not changed and as such, the County's offer has been rejected.

Mr. Bartlett stated per Section 15.2-1903 of the *Code of Virginia*, "Prior to initiating condemnation proceedings, the governing body shall, after a public hearing adopt a resolution or ordinance approving the proposed public use and directing the acquisition of property for the public use by condemnation or other means."

Chairman Fore opened the Public Hearing.

Jack Houghton, Farmville District, urged the Board to cease the practice of holding special meetings regarding the expenditure of large sums of money; these should be discussed at regular board meetings. He then expressed his concern about the cost of the acquisition of property for the Alternate 628 Project, and that it now is approaching \$1,000,000 just for the Right of Way. He added he supports economic development but it is important to have a plan of costs and sequence of events.

There being no one further wishing to speak, Chairman Fore closed the Public Hearing.

Supervisor Wilck inquired about the status of the developer's funding sources and if they are secured. Mr. Bartlett stated he has no firm answer from the developer.

Supervisor Simpson made a motion to adopt the Resolution Authorizing the Acquisition of Interests in Real Estate For Road Construction Purposes on Land Owned by Davis Real Properties, LLC, Tax Map #051-9-A for public use, the construction of Route 786 (Alt 628) and directing the acquisition of the property needed for the construction and the acquisition of the property needed for the utility easements.

Supervisor Wilck stated that he is opposed due to the developer having no firm word on his funding.

Supervisor Campbell stated this should have been included in one public hearing; Mr. Bartlett stated another Supervisor had requested further negotiations be attempted with Davis Real Properties LLC, and had held considerable meetings with the family in order to come to an agreement.

Supervisor Cooper-Jones asked about the ramification if the decision would be delayed until the regular board meeting; Mr. Bartlett stated the construction company that won the bid to build the road will not hold the price any longer. He added the majority of the Board of Supervisors voted to build the road due to traffic congestion with Route 628 and Route 15 and safety concerns for the school campus, not because of economic development.

Chairman Fore then restated Supervisor Simpson's motion to adopt the Resolution Authorizing the Acquisition of Interests in Real Estate For Road Construction Purposes on Land Owned by Davis Real Properties, LLC, Tax Map #051-9-A for public use, the construction of Route 786 (Alt 628) and directing the acquisition of the property needed for the construction and the acquisition of the property needed for the utility easements; the motion carried:

**A Resolution Authorizing the Acquisition of Interests in Real Estate
For Road Construction Purposes on land Owned by
Davis Real properties, LLC, Tax Map #051-9-A**

WHEREAS, Prince Edward County, Virginia (the "County") and the Commonwealth of Virginia have undertaken to construct an alternate to State Route 628 (to be named State Route 786) to relieve congestion through the Prince Edward County School Complex and to enhance safety in the area; and

WHEREAS, the County has determined that there is a need for a 0.919 acre right of way along with a 0.433 acre utility easement across and through a portion of a certain property identified by Tax Map Number 051-9-A, located on the east side of U.S. Highway 15, just south of Dominion Drive; and

WHEREAS, due to the deadlines imposed in conjunction with the construction of the highway utilizing “quick take” procedures as authorized by Section 15.2-1905(C) of the *Code of Virginia, 1950*, as amended, is necessary; and

WHEREAS, the value of the right of way and the easement is \$56,691.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County, that condemnation utilizing “quick take” procedures of a 0.919 acre right of way and 0.433 acre utility easement that must be relocated to accommodate construction across and through portions of the property identified as Tax Map Number 051-9-A, located on the east side of U.S. Highway 15, just south of Dominion Drive is necessary for the reasons set forth in this Resolution, and staff is hereby authorized to initiate condemnation proceedings, including possession prior to the institution of the condemnation proceedings in accordance with law.

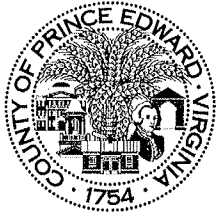

In November with the issuance of the VRA Bonds the County refunded three bonds – the \$1,370,000 revenue bond issued through Rural Development, the \$3.5 million G.O. Bond issued in 1998 for Courthouse construction and the \$2.13 million Construction Bond issued through Rural Development. This action allows the County to deobligate payments for those bonds which totals \$353,008.

The new bonds issued require an interest only payment in April 2012 totaling \$106,790. The difference of \$246,218 can be returned to the fund balance.

The Mission Of the Piedmont Soil and Water Conservation District is to provide technical, educational and financial resources to the citizens of Prince Edward, Nottoway, and Amelia Counties in order to promote the wise use and conservation of soil, water and related resources. The PSWCD is an Organization of elected and appointed volunteers and trained staff that guides decision-makers and stakeholders in the conservation of soil and water.

Regarding: Contacting legislative representatives to restore SWCD funding

Proposed reductions in the state's budget leave a serious gap in your Soil and Water District's capacity to manage the state's agricultural cost-share program, and the District's capacity to assist our localities in Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) implementation needed to meet the water quality goals set forth by EPA. The state is expecting localities to make up the funding shortfalls. Please consider contacting your legislative representatives in support of the two budget amendments outlined below:

Restore & make permanent the \$1 million/year increase in essential operations funding for Virginia's 47 Soil and Water Conservation Districts approved by the 2011 General Assembly and deleted in the Governor's 2013-2014 budget. The Virginia Soil and Water Conservation Board has approved a minimum of \$124,000 that is required annually for each SWCD to meet their essential operating costs. Current funding meets only 65% of this minimum amount. With the proposed cut of \$1M, funding will only meet 54% of this minimum amount. **Piedmont SWCD will face a \$21,000 reduction in essential funding**

Restore technical assistance funding by \$1,046,840 per year to sustain essential positions, to implement TMDLs in the Chesapeake Bay and Southern Rivers basins. The reduction of \$1,046,840 statewide from the proposed Governor's budget would **eliminate two full-time and one-part time conservation technical positions at the Piedmont SWCD.** Statewide the proposed cut would eliminate **26 positions.**

The two proposed cuts of \$2,046,840 accounts for over 32% of SWCD's current funding - far in excess of the Governor's request of 2-4-6% reductions.

In addition to SWCD's managing the state's agricultural cost share program and offering technical assistance to our local farmers, we are also assisting with the Chesapeake Bay Implementation Plans. Localities located within the Chesapeake Bay Watershed (which includes all or part of each of our three counties) are being asked to participate in developing an implementation plan to address land use and water quality concerns in the watershed. Agricultural land use and best management practices are a big part of those plans. Piedmont SWCD has been reviewing data and assisting our localities with identifying what has been installed and defining strategies to meet the water quality goals. As funds continue to be cut we will not have staff available to continue this assistance.

In November 2010 the Piedmont SWCD arranged a farm tour for Senate staff members to experience first hand the complexity of planning, installing and maintaining agricultural best management cost shared practices. The benefits of these practices were overwhelmingly obvious as was the need for funding to finance the program, resulting in the additional \$1M funding in the FY12 budget that was subsequently slashed.

The loss of this crucial funding will impact not only our agricultural communities and water quality, but will affect the economy of the localities we represent - Amelia, Nottoway & Prince Edward counties. We hope you will let your legislative representatives know how valuable our services are to your locality and our communities.
