Use of Courthouse Lawn

Summary:

The County has received a request from Mr. Taikein Cooper to hold an event on the Courthouse lawn to raise money and awareness for homelessness on the night of Saturday, December 2, 2017. Mr. Cooper has held this event for the last several years on Longwood's campus. He will be donating any money raised to STEPS.

The event will commence at 10:00 pm on December 2nd and conclude around 5:00 am on December 3rd. Approximately 10 people will participate. They will place chairs and a table or two on the lawn and possible a shade tent/canopy like you see at festivals. The participants may watch movies on a laptop but there will be no loud music or other activities that will disturb anyone. Mostly the participants will be sleeping outside to raise money and awareness of homelessness. Once the event has concluded Mr. Cooper has agreed to be responsible for all clean-up of the lawn.

The County does not have a permit requirement for this type of event. We handle requests for use of the Courthouse Lawn on a case by case basis.
