#### Summary:

1. The <u>Commonwealth's Attorney</u> is requesting an appropriation of \$12,500 from the Forfeited Asset Fund. The funds will be used to purchase (1) A copier, (2) workstation, (3) projector, and (4) Computers/software.

The office copier is over 10 years old and the vendor can no longer find parts for the machine, the next time a part breaks the office will have no copier capability. Additionally, the Office FAX machine is not working a new copier can double as a FAX machine which will eliminate the need to purchase a new FAX and also is cheaper to operate. A new copier will cost \$6,000. The workstation will cost \$1,100. A projector will cost \$700 and is needed to present evidence in court cases. Finally four computers and associated software need to be replaced due to age and unreliability. These computers are used by attorneys in the presentation of cases.

2. <u>CDA Special Tax Levy</u> – The Poplar Hill Community Development Authority has requested the County appropriate the Special Tax Levy imposed on property in the CDA District and distribute the amounts paid at this time.
