This is a formal request that the Board of Supervisors support and approve the 2009-2010 School Board budget as proposed.

Much like you, the school board has agonized and labored to provide a budget that both reflected its understanding of the current economic conditions and provide us the best opportunity to continue to effectively educate our children.

This budget request reflects significant reductions in every possible category. We slashed expenditures for materials/supplies, professional training expenses and equipment purchases. This request also reflects the elimination, reassignment and /or realignment of several personnel positions.

As you can see, this budget required the school board to make some tough and unpopular decisions. However, we are confident that a fully funded budget request will allow us to effectively support our charge, to adequately educate our children.

Lastly, although I am cognizant of the current economic conditions, I am focusing on our future and I am confident you will once again make the appropriate decision to best support our children and invest in Prince Edward's future.

Additionally, I am again appealing for consideration regarding my two previous request, support for the carry-over of unexpended funds from the 2008-2009 academic year and to eliminate the budget category restrictions.
