**Draft L & A Testing Minutes**

**DATE:** April 25, 2017

**PURPOSE:** L & A Testing for June 13<sup>th</sup> Primary Election (Democratic & Republican)

**PRESENT:** Members: Chairman, Sam Martin, Vice-Chair Gordon Smith, and newly elected Secretary Gwendolyn Akers-Booker. General Registrar Lynette Wright was present. The meeting was held in the Registrar's office.

The meeting was called to order at 1:30 PM by Secretary Gwendolyn Akers-Booker.

Members of the Board were presented with the list of poll workers to be reviewed and approved. The Secretary informed the board that there were a few individuals that would be trained during the next training date which will be June 1<sup>st</sup> with two sessions (9-11am and 5-7pm) held at Prince Edward Elks Lodge. Letters were mailed to all workers asking that they contact the General Registrar with the time in which they would be arriving for training.

L & A Testing began and it was a smooth transition. All machines were visited with a few items to be addressed. The PCU units for all locations were checked and verified based on state requirements and the screens were tested and cleaned with proper seals attached to each PCU unit. Upon completion of the units and screens, they were stored in a secured location.

For the June 13<sup>th</sup> Primary Election, CAP is open from April 28 – June 10, 2017. This is available for individuals who will not be able to vote on the actual day of election which is considered Absentee Voting.
