Old Dominion EMS Alliance has provided effective coordination of emergency medical services (EMS) for more than 27 years to local governments and their citizens. Due to increasing responsibilities for coordination and implementation of regional patient care issues with no corresponding increase in state funding, ODEMSA is asking for your financial assistance.

The ODEMSA Board of Directors requests that each locality make an immediate financial contribution of 10% (ten percent) of your \$4-for-life Return to Localities Funds to ODEMSA. In addition we ask that you appropriate the same in your FY09 budget.

Dear Ms. Puckett,

This letter is in follow up to our phone conversation from this morning.

On May 17<sup>th</sup> 2007 I conducted an inspection of the Rice Volunteer Fire Department to renew their EMS Agency license. During the course of the inspection several deficiencies were noted. Those noted were failure to report patient care reports to the Office of EMS, agency did not have an updated Operational Medical Director agreement, quality management of EMS calls not being performed, as well as vehicle maintenance records not up to date.

As a result of these deficiencies the license for the fire department was renewed only until August 31<sup>st</sup> 2007. During this time the agency was to correct these issues and contact me for reinspection. I have been contacted by the agency to answer questions regarding these matters but to date have not been notified that they have been corrected. On August 31<sup>st</sup> 2007 the agency license for the fire department expired and remains expired at this time. At that time the agency was to notify the dispatch center that they could not respond to EMS calls.

As always, the Office of EMS is willing to assist the fire department in any way possible to correct these issues and regain their license.
