At a reconvened meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Prince Edward County, held in the Third Floor Conference Room of the Court House, on Monday the 25th day of June, 2007; at 7:00 p.m., there were present:

Chairman William G. Fore, Jr., called the meeting to order.

In Re: Proposed Prince Edward County Zoning Ordinance

Chairman Fore stated the purpose of the meeting was to review the Zoning Ordinance in a work session. He said that Jonathan Pickett sent a Memorandum to the Board members suggesting changes based on the public hearings on the Zoning Ordinance. He then turned the floor over to Mr. Pickett.

Mr. Pickett explained that the synopsis provided in his memo pertained to the more controversial issues which surfaced at Public Hearings and through direct citizen contact. The first topic of discussion was the minimum lot size, frontage and setback requirements in the A-1 (Agricultural Conservation) District. Sally Gilfillan clarified that the 2 acre lot size with 250 feet of road frontage is in accord with the recommendations of the Planning Commission. Bobby Jones stated that the 2 acre lot size with a density of 4 acres is still the recommendation of the Planning Commission for the Agricultural Conservation District. The Board members were reminded that the Cluster Housing Overlay District can be used in the A-1

District which would allow lot sizes as small as 1.00 acre. Sally Gilfillan expressed concern that the Zoning Ordinance addresses affordability of land for low income families. After much discussion, Mr. Fore called for consensus for the 1 ½ acre lot size with only 200 feet of road frontage. Mr. Jones did not concur with the group stating that he felt the 2 acre lot size was a recommendation that the Planning Commission had worked hard to develop for the purpose of separating the Agricultural Conservation area from the Agricultural Residential area which allows the smaller lot size.

Mr. Pickett continued with the next topic of "Farm Stand Development Regulations." There was consensus to omit that section from the proposed Zoning Ordinance.

"Accessory Apartments" was the third topic. Two changes to the language printed in the 5th Draft, dated February 5, 2007 of the proposed Zoning Ordinance were consented by the Board: omit the requirement for a family member to be the only allowable occupant of an accessory apartment and delete Item 6, page 67 which prohibits separate utility service for the accessory apartment.

Attention then turned to "Home Occupations". There was consensus to include the term "on site" in the definition to read, "An accessory use of a dwelling unit for gainful employment involving the *on site* production, provision, or sale of goods and/or services." Items restricting employment to family members, and prohibiting retail sales from a home occupation, were deleted. The restrictions on the maximum number of individuals that could receive lessons in the fine arts, tutoring, or childcare in a home were also deleted. There was consensus to reword Item (B) 7 to read "Signs greater than 6 square feet require a Special Use Permit." External storage of materials or equipment associated with the Home Occupation was discussed. Mr. Pickett suggested that external storage be permitted as long as the materials cannot be seen from neighboring properties or public roadways and pointed to the use of fences or small buildings. There was discussion of changing the language in Item (B) 9 to reflect the external storage suggestion in a positive manner, "If there is external storage of equipment or materials associated with the home occupation, it must be kept out of view from neighboring properties or public roadways." The second sentence of Item (B) 11. was changed to read, "Incidental deliveries common to residential dwellings, such as by UPS, FedEx, or similar carriers, shall be permitted."

"Site Plans" on page 93 was discussed. It was agreed to leave that section intact in the proposed ordinance. Sally Gilfillan suggested that charging fees for site plans be considered.

No additions or changes were approved to Section 4-200.15 "Additional Requirements for Exterior Storage..."

The deletion of Section 4-400.17, Location and Design of Fences" was agreed upon by the members.

No changes were approved to Section 5-104 "Zoning Permits".

Mr. Pickett suggested several deletions in the sections pertaining to nonconforming uses. There was consent to delete Item (B) on p. 135, the last paragraph on page 136 under Section 5-126.3 Item (A) 3, items (B0 and (C) of Section 5-126.3, and Item (A) 2 of Section 5-126.5.

The definition of "Outdoor Gathering" was adjusted by the deletion of "church revival" from the definition on page 173.

All "Accessory Structure" Setbacks were deleted from the proposed ordinance.

The standards pertaining to the "Bed and Breakfast" use, as described on page 80, were discussed with the following changes agreed upon: Delete the requirement for the owner to reside on the parcel occupied by the bed and breakfast, delete the second sentence of Item (A)3 which prohibited bedrooms from having direct access to the outside of the building, delete Item (A)5 which limited meal service to guests, and delete the owner occupied requirement in the definition on page 165.

There was consensus to adjust the 180 day term in the "Construction, Start" definition on page 146 to a two year term which agrees with current building permit requirements.

Mr. Pickett explained that the current Zoning Ordinance allows "Two Family Dwellings" by-right in the Agricultural District. In the proposed ordinance, a duplex in the Agricultural Conservation and Agricultural Residential Districts would be permitted by a special use permit. Town homes are not allowed in the Agricultural Conservation District, but are allowed in the Agricultural Residential District with Special Use Permit. Adding the duplex use as a by-right use in the Agricultural Residential and maintaining it as a Special Use in the Agricultural Conservation was discussed. Mr. McKay suggested adding the "Two Family Dwelling" use as a by-right use in both Agricultural Districts.

A citizen raised the question of business licensure requirements for the Home Occupations and the resulting business tax revenues to the County. Merchant Capital Taxes and Business License fees were discussed, with Mr. Bartlett pointing out that a locality cannot charge both. Mrs. Gilfillan expressed her

concern that the cost of local government is paid by landowners through their property taxes, and that other revenue streams should be explored.

A citizen also requested that the County utilize an Open Space Plan to protect community features such as parks and to protect the rural nature of the area.

Mr. Fore asked whether the presentation of the revised proposed ordinance should be through public hearing or a public information session. It was decided that initially it should be presented through an information session, with an option of a subsequent public hearing if deemed necessary. A Public Information Session to present the final draft of the proposed zoning ordinance was scheduled for Tuesday, July 17 at 7 p.m. The final draft of the document will need to be prepared at least two weeks prior to the meeting and public advertising by radio and newspaper should also begin two weeks prior to July 17.

Mr. Fore stated that the Board would reconvene tomorrow at noon as a joint meeting with the Farmville Town Council for the purpose of discussing the Sandy River Reservoir. He asked if anyone wanted to discuss the topic during this work session. Sally Gilfillan expressed that Longwood University, Hampden-Sydney College, and Southside Community Hospital have a stake in determining a secure water supply and should be included in related discussions.

1. Funding for High Bridge Trail State Park – The Board of Supervisors requests that the Governor and Virginia General Assembly include \$10.29 million in the State Budget to fund the capital costs of constructing the Rice to Prospect corridor of High Bridge Trail State Park and include \$541,000 in the budget of the Department of Conservation and Recreation for operating costs to open High Bridge Trail State Park.
2. Lottery Funding for Education – The County of Prince Edward requests that the Virginia General Assembly consider revising the way in which the state disburses lottery funds so that the financial benefits are felt more fully in smaller, rural school districts.
3. Judicial Funding – The Board of Supervisors requests that the Virginia General Assembly create and fund a new Judgeship for the 10th Circuit.
4. Transportation Funding – The County of Prince Edward urges the General Assembly to make transportation a primary focus of the 2008 Session and to provide for enhanced and/or new funding strategies for maintenance and capital funding.
5. Revenue Sharing Program – The Board of Supervisors requests amendments to Section 33.1-23.05 of the *Code of Virginia*, to restore the Revenue Sharing Program to the structure that existed prior to the 2006 Session of the General Assembly.
6. Comprehensive Services Act – The Board of Supervisors requests that the Virginia General Assembly provide that court-ordered children be classified as “mandated” for the purposes of receiving state reimbursements.
7. Water Quality and Sufficiency – The County of Prince Edward requests that the Virginia General Assembly insure that adequate funding is available to localities for the implementation of the state-mandated water supply plans.
8. Land Use & Planning – The County of Prince Edward adamantly opposes any legislation that will weaken the ability of local governments to control the growth, planning and land use decisions within its boundaries.
9. Agriculture and Natural Resources – The County of Prince Edward strongly encourages the Virginia General Assembly to invest more state dollars and agency services in the support of living landscapes/production agriculture to ensure a sustainable future where our lands can provide food for our citizens, resource materials for the production of alternative energy (such as bio-diesel and bio-mass), and conservation of natural resources and wildlife habitat through incentives such as conservation easements and Purchase of Development Rights which also promote long-term protection of the environment of the Commonwealth.
10. Broadband – The County of Prince Edward requests that the Virginia General Assembly continue the work of the Virginia Tobacco Commission by funding “the last mile” of broadband in rural Virginia.

11. Local Taxing Authority – The County of Prince Edward supports legislation that expands the ability of local governments to generate new, equitable revenue streams, by means other than increasing local property taxes.
12. Situs for Taxation – Amending Section 58.1-3511A requiring that situs for assessment and taxation of personal property, merchants capital and machinery and tools (would not include motor vehicles, travel trailers, boats and airplanes which are already assessed based on where they are “normally garaged, docked or parked”) be the county, district, town or city in which the property is “normally used, located or held out for sale” instead of where the property “may be physically located on tax day”. The purpose of the change is to prevent tax payers from being able to move their tangible personal property, merchants capital or machinery and tools out of the locality where the property is normally kept throughout the year on “tax day” in order to avoid being assessed for the tax by claiming that the property was not “physically located” in the locality on tax day.

During the past year, the Commonwealth Regional Council has proposed that the region's localities jointly establish a set of "regional legislative" priorities to pursue during sessions of the General Assembly. Several meetings have been held regarding this effort and the Chief Administrative Officers have discussed it during their monthly meetings with the CRC staff.

At the June 7, 2007 meeting of the Commonwealth Regional Council, the Council decided on a process for developing a regional set of legislative priorities. For those local governments who are participating in funding this effort, there are two action items that require your immediate attention.

First, the participating localities need to appoint an individual to serve on the Regional Legislative Priorities Committee. We strongly recommend that your locality appoint your current serving member of the Commonwealth Regional Council, if that is acceptable. As the Council discussed at its meeting, these individuals are familiar with each other and can quickly implement this program. Please forward the name of your appointee to Danny Fore at the CRC at your earliest convenience. We would like to receive the appointments not later than July 15, 2007, if possible.

Second, to develop a strong regional legislative agenda, we ask that your locality provide a brief description of what you view to be the top 3 to 5 regional project priorities. A simple form for listing these is included with this letter. It is imperative that these projects be regional in nature. Either "locality-specific or statewide issues" are not recommended as we try to establish a firm footing for the region with General Assembly Members from around the Commonwealth. We would also like to receive these project priorities not later than July 31, 2007 so that the Committee can complete its work by August 31, 2007. This will allow the Committee to provide the priorities to the appropriate State agencies and to General Assembly Members in a timely manner. The Council will also request potential projects from non-profit organizations within the region.

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The Regional Legislative Priorities Committee will prioritize the submitted projects as they determine how best to proceed. This will be a biennial process that runs concurrently with the Commonwealth's two-year budget process and in recognition that regional efforts are often multi-year in nature. The process will be ongoing. Once the process is fully developed, it will provide an action plan for the future that should assist the region in obtaining increased State funding for regional projects. The Legislative Priorities Committee will refine the plan and work through changes as necessary.

Again, please ensure that the projects which you submit are regional in nature. While we encourage you to provide your locality's legislative package, this process is an entirely different undertaking.

The Commonwealth Regional Council appreciates your assistance and support of this request. The Council believes that by working together, the Commonwealth Region's localities can craft a reasonable and significant list of projects and goals that will benefit area residents and help grow the economy of the region.

Earlier this year we voted to have a budget committee of the whole. In addition, we agreed to set aside time this summer to review the budgets of our volunteer service agencies. I requested that we also begin looking at the budget in a zero-based mode rather than incremental. Our practice to date, the incremental mode, consisted of taking last years' budget and then increasing or decreasing based on last years' amount. A zero based mode departs from that practice and instead looks at the new year as a blank slate. Each area is considered to start at zero in a new year's budget and each requested item is built in as needed or requested for the coming year. It is possible that could be accomplished by Mr. Bartlett over several months. We need his recommendation and expertise.

I request that we discuss the above with Mr. Bartlett and ask him to design the process to accomplish the above. I am bringing this forth as an information item tonight. To give everyone time to think about it, I suggest we discuss it no later than the August board meeting.

**GOVERNOR KAINES ANNOUNCES \$77 MILLION INVESTMENT IN
PRINCE EDWARD COUNTY**

~ *Poplar Hill Golf Club Inn and Conference Center to create 180 jobs* ~

RICHMOND – Governor Timothy M. Kaine today announced the development of Poplar Hill Golf Club Inn and Conference Center, a \$77 million, multi-use recreational facility that will boost the economy of Prince Edward County and the surrounding region. The project, located south of Farmville on U.S. Route 15, is expected to create 180 jobs, ranging from grounds crews to event planners.

"This project is an excellent example of successful collaboration," said Governor Kaine. "Public and private partners including Hampden-Sydney College, Longwood University, Prince Edward County, the Town of Farmville and the developer, Poplar Hill Holdings, LLC, have joined forces to increase tourism while providing a great source for workforce training and employment in the hospitality field."

Poplar Hill Holdings is developing a master plan resort, spa and country club community on 1,020 acres. Plans include an 18-hole golf course, which is already open, a club house, the restoration of the old Victorian Manor House as part of a 120-

unit inn and conference center, 40 duplexes and cottages. A spa and fitness center will be offered, as well as a sports club including swimming and tennis and open recreational space and trails with the potential for an equestrian center. The inn and conference center are slated for completion within three years. The development of middle- to upper-income single family homes is planned over the next 10 years, with lots ready for sale later this year.

"We are delighted to have been able to partner with Prince Edward County, the Poplar Hill Community Development Authority, Hampden-Sydney College, Longwood University and the Town of Farmville, and local sponsors to enable such an extraordinary development for the community," said Michael Heffernan, Managing Partner, Herberton Group and Poplar Hill Holdings. "We have created a formula through the creative mix of public and private finance to catalyze economic growth and development, tourism and strategic partnerships in education and training to build a lasting legacy for Southside Virginia and Prince Edward County. Poplar Hill will generate more than \$47 million in taxes for Prince Edward County over the next 25 years."

The Virginia Tobacco Indemnification and Community Revitalization Commission approved \$1 million in special projects funds toward infrastructure improvements to support the project. The company is eligible to receive state benefits from the Virginia Enterprise Zone Program, administered by the Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development, because it is locating in a Virginia Enterprise Zone.

"The development of the Poplar Hill Golf Course, Inn and Conference Center will help establish the infrastructure that Prince Edward County needs to fully emerge as a tourism destination," said William G. Fore Jr., Chairman of the Prince Edward County Board of Supervisors. "The Board of Supervisors recognizes the importance of tourism as an economic development priority.
