Sharon then stated that due to Industrial Park Restrictions, certain nuisance clauses and non-compete clauses that LOWES wanted on the adjoining property, the following proposals were approved and recommended to the IDA by the Prince Edward County Board of Supervisors at their June 17, 2007 called meeting.

- Approval of the IDA to offer LOWES a purchase option on 1.695 acres adjoining the north side of the proposed LOWES 13 acre property. "For the sum of \$10.00 LOWES can obtain a purchase option on the adjoining 1.695 acres at the price of \$100,000 per acre, which is the current asking price for the store site of 13 acres."
- In addition, the Board of Supervisors agreed to waive the Industrial Park Covenants on the 13 acres and the 1.695 aces.

On a motion made by Gwen Eddleman and seconded by Virginia Price, it was recommended that the IDA Board give LOWES Home Center a Purchase Option on the 1.695 acres adjoining the 13 acre tract; and to give the IDA Chairman authority to sign the Special Warranty Deed, Option Agreement and all appropriate documents associated with the sale of the 13 acres and the option for the 1.695 acres. The motion was accepted by the following vote.
