\$3,800 was paid to Harold W. Collins Clearing & Grading for moving of dirt and installation of drainage pipe needed for the construct of a temporary entrance to accommodate the logging activities at the Industrial Park.

\$10,000 was paid to Hurt & Proffitt for preliminary road design and budget for the access road at the Industrial Park, which was necessary for inclusion in grant applications.

Prince Edward County has submitted three grants to the Tobacco Commission for funding of the new Access Road at the Industrial Park for a total of \$571,960. (See updated project budget attached.)

Economic Development Access Funds-Application Pending

In October, Prince Edward County submitted an application to VDOT for Revenue Sharing funds to construct the new Access Road. VDOT staff has recommended this request be amended and submitted to VDOT for Economic Development Access Funds consideration. With the assistance of VDOT personnel, the new grant will be resubmitted in 2016. These funds will be used towards the design, engineering, and construction of the Access Road.

The Economic Development Access Funds are limited to \$500,000 \$500,000

Timbering of 60+/- acres at the Prince Edward County Industrial Park

Timber Project

On November 20, 2015, bids to timber 60+/- acres of undeveloped land at the Prince Edward Industrial Park was conducted. There was only one bidder, who came in lower than anticipated at \$50,000. There seemed to be some real issues as to the timing of the project and the extremely wet weather. This lower bid may result in the IDA potentially having to add more money to the cost of the access road, which will be predicated on the amount at which the construction costs come in.

Contribution

At this time the amount of a potential funding short fall for the Access Road Project is yet to be determined. The County has been very fortunate in the support from the Tobacco Commission. The amount needed from the IDA may vary depending on VDOT Economic Access Funds, and how low the construction bids come in.

Mr. Showalter asked Sharon to give an update on the progress of the sale of LOT 7-A, consisting of 3.489 acres at the Prince Edward Industrial Park to Tri-Boro Rack. Sharon stated that at the May 10, 2016 Prince Edward County Board of Supervisors Meeting, the Board consented to the offered sales price for the 3.489 acres at \$20,000 per acre for a total of \$69,780. Unfortunately after speaking with Mr. Demaio's attorney, there seems to be an issue with the Title Company regarding the assessed value of LOT 7-A per acre in "comparison" to the proposed sales price per acre. Mr. Demaio is requesting the IDA submit to the Board of Equalization a petition requesting the assessed value (tax base) be reduced to be more in line with the sales price or the appraised value conducted August 30, 2014 by MG Miller, which was \$50,186 per acre.

After some discussion, Tim Tharpe made a motion for the IDA to move forward with the Petition to the Board of Equalization regarding the reduction of the assessed value for the LOT 7-A property at the Prince Edward Industrial Park.
