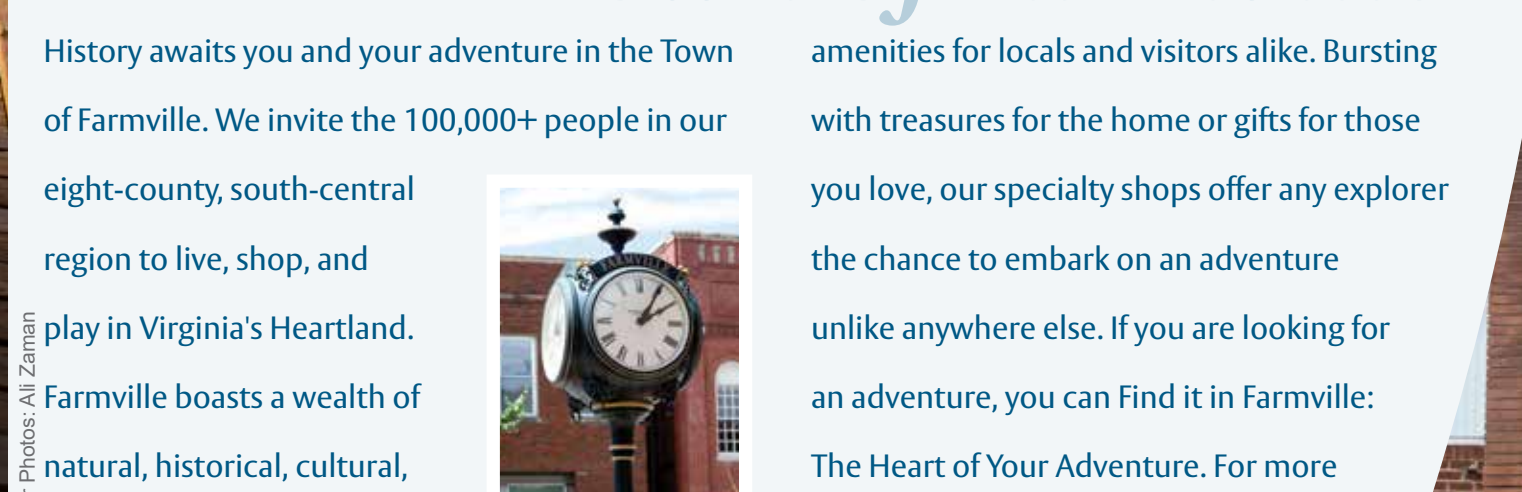


Prince Edward County

History

Prince Edward County and the Town of Farmville were formed, respectively, in 1754 and 1798, and are home to some of the most critical moments of American history:

- The last battles of the American Civil War at Sailor's Creek Battlefield Historical State Park;
- The last struggle between the Union and the Confederacy for control of High Bridge, 125 feet above the Appomattox River; and
- The birthplace of the student-led Civil Rights Movement, the Robert Russa Moton Museum. It is a National Historic Landmark and part of the expanded Brown v. Board of Education National Historic Site in Kansas.

Whether your adventure is to walk the path of your ancestors or retrace the steps of American history, Farmville and Prince Edward County are at The Heart of Your Adventure.

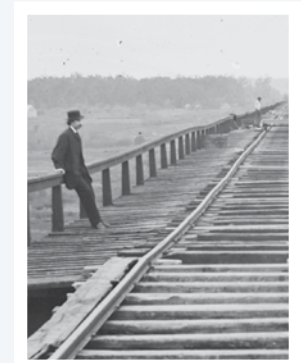

Outdoor Adventures

The Manor Golf Club, an 18-hole links course, is situated between the Town of Farmville and Hampden-Sydney College.

The Town of Farmville offers Wilck's Lake, the Sarah Terry Walking Trail, Dogwood Trail, and a Skateboard Park. For the adventurous traveler, try ziplining at the Sandy River Outdoor Adventure Park in Rice, Virginia.

Three Virginia State Parks invite guests pursuing outdoor adventures: High Bridge Trail State Park, 31 miles long and great for hiking, bicycling, and horseback riding; Twin Lakes State Park, an important part of Civil Rights history and a popular choice for swimming, camping, hiking, and events; and Sailor's Creek Battlefield Historical State Park. Two additional state parks within 30 minutes of Farmville include Bear Creek Lake and Holliday Lake State Parks. For those that enjoy fishing, Prince Edward County also offers the Briery Creek Wildlife Management Area and Sandy River Reservoir.
