- A third and final payment to Paris Ceramics in the amount of \$15,500 to purchase the Intra CNC 36 vendor was made on May 5, 2014. The machine has now been installed and is working fine. A new machine operator, with experience in operating such machinery while recently in the Army, has been added to the Paris Ceramics staff.
- Due to the interest of a perspective purchaser for lots 7A and 7B at the Prince Edward Business Park, an appraisal was conducted by M G Miller from Richmond at the cost of \$2,500. Negotiations for the perspective sale are still in progress. Having the current appraisal available is a definite help in trying to determine the value of the lot to a potential purchaser.
- A final payment on the Paris Ceramics \$164,000 equipment loan is due to be paid by December 31, 2014. The estimated payment amount is \$6,546.73. This leaves Paris Ceramics with 3 loans remaining:

Intra 36 CNC Saw balance (\$155,000)	\$132,132.22

As of this date, there is still no word on the disposition of the Manor Golf Course, or when the \$50,000 IDA loan will be paid.
