for any resident and qualified voter of District 1, who wishes to be considered, to complete and return a Board of

Supervisors Vacancy - Citizen Application to the County Administrator's Office by no later than 4:00 p.m. on Friday,

July 29, 2022. A press release was also issued.

To date the County has received a total of two (2) applications for the seat. Based on the 45-day time limit,

the Board must make an appointment by August 19, 2022.

Upon appointment, this individual will serve on the Board of Supervisors and exercise all powers of the

elected office until the Special Election to fill the vacancy is held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022 and the person so

elected has qualified. Supervisor Booth's term of office would have ended December 31, 2023. The individual elected

in the special election for District 1 will serve until December 31, 2023 and is then eligible to run for re-election in

the November 2023 election, if they so choose.
