

CITIZEN VOLUNTEER POSITIONS PRINCE EDWARD COUNTY

To encourage citizen participation in our local government, it is the policy of the Prince Edward County Board of Supervisors to advertise vacancies on county boards, commissions and committees, etc., which call for citizen representation. The following terms of office expire December 31, 2024:

County Board of Zoning Appeals	5 Years	1 Position ¹
County Planning Commission	4 Years	1 County Position ²
County Tourism Council	2 Years	8 Positions
Crossroads Community Services Board	3 Years	1 Position

Notes:

- 1. The Board makes a recommendation to the Circuit Court Judge for positions on the BZA.
- 2. The Board of Supervisors has voted to realign the Planning Commission. Future vacancies will be filled by election district. Individuals wishing to apply for the current "county position" vacancy should live in District 2 (Lockett) or District 3 (Leigh).

Citizens interested in being considered must submit a *Citizen Volunteer Application* to the County Administrator's Office by not later than Monday, December 2, 2024.
