What is a Risk Limiting Audit? A risk-limiting audit is a post-election audit that gives a statistical level of confidence that the outcome of an election is correct. It provides evidence that the ballot tabulators counted the ballots accurately. This helps ensure—and reassure—the public that the reported winner really got the most votes.
